CANSKATE PROGRAM

Learn to Skate

A Skate Canada learn to skate program where basic skating skills are taught in group settings by professionally trained Skate Canada coaches. Badges are awarded as skaters master the fundamental skating skills. CanSkate is the feeder program to all other Skate Canada Programs. Includes 10 minutes of warm-up and a 30 minute group lesson with 5 minutes of cool down. This program is designed for Hockey, Ringette & Figure Skating.

Requirement:

- Must be 3yrs of age as of December 31, 2018

INTROSKATE PROGRAM
