Learn to Skate

A Skate Canada learn-to-skate program where basic skating skills are taught in group settings by professionally-trained Skate Canada coaches. Badges are awarded as skaters master the fundamental skating skills. CanSkate is the feeder program to all other Skate Canada Programs. Includes 10 minutes of warm-up and a 30-minute group lesson with 5 minutes of cool down. This program is designed for Hockey, Ringette & Figure Skating.
